February 2023

- We have been carrying out work to make your local area safer. This newsletter contains a summary of some of the community safety work that has taken place over the last year.

Project highlights

- Resident engagement, including a coffee morning at New Orleans Community Centre in November.
- 5 bleed control cabinets installed
- 70 bleed control kits distributed to community members
- 16 Safe Havens signed up
- 32 young people taking part in bike maintenance sessions
- 14 young people from a local school enrolled in a City & Guilds - level 3 cycle mechanics course
- Workshops delivered by the Ben Kinsella Trust, including to 10 schools in the area
- First Aid at Work qualification awarded to young people participating in the Street Doctors programme

Safe havens, knife bins and bleed control cabinet locations

Safe havens

A Safe haven is a public building where people can go if they are feeling unsafe or need help. A blue 'Safe haven' sticker is displayed in the window to show they are part of this scheme. We have recruited 15 Safe Havens in Hillrise this year.

Bleed control kits

We installed five bleed control cabinets, which can be accessed by calling 999 and asking for the code to the cabinet.

We distributed 70 bleed control kits to community leaders and residents in the ward who are often first on the scene after serious violence.

The bleed control kits contain special dressings and bandages, which have been designed to seal wounds and control serious bleeding, as well as basic instructions. The vital few minutes after an injury or wound occurs are often critical in preventing death in the cases of severe bleeding.
