Antenatal and Postnatal Midwifery Clinics

Breastfeeding Support

Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND)

Chatterpillars

Communication focussed Stay and Play course, sharing strategies with parents to support their child's expressive language needs.

SENDsory Adventures

SENDsory Adventures is a small specialist group for parents and children who have been referred to the Social Communication Team (SCT) and are awaiting an assessment.

Speech and Language Therapy

Bright Start Speech and Language Therapists support children with speech, language and communication needs by sharing strategies and advice with parents during visits to Stay and Plays and parent workshops.
