Find a knife bin

Our top priority is keeping our community safe, which is why we have installed nine knife bins around the borough. Knife bins are a safe and secure place for people to dispose of a knife, blade or tool, without fear of prosecution. Every knife disposed of represents a decision for a better future.

When you are taking a knife, blade or tools to the knife bin carefully wrap it in cardboard (such as an old cereal box) and use strong tape to secure it. Use enough cardboard and tape so the knife doesn't poke through.

Though it is a criminal offence to have a knife or blade in a public place, it is okay to have one when it is securely wrapped and you are taking it straight to a knife bin.
